We see at least three main purposes for this trip:

1) It is training and discipleship for those who participate as they learn about the land, people and history of Israel - a place where truly the Bible comes alive. Study and worship will take place at many of the sites visited from the Desert to the Sea of Galilee to Jerusalem. Experiencing Israel first hand will serve the student well in teaching others for generations to come. Our goal is to also see Israel as it is today, to understand God's heart and promises for this land and this people, and to further prepare us for ministry while we are there.

2) To minister to Israel – the people. We do this by showing our love, support and communicating through the ministry of dance - a language well received in this culture. In a land forsaken by most of the world the Jewish people are amazed and grateful for the hope and joy we bring to them through their own dances. We are truly comforting Zion while we proclaim that our God still reigns and loves them. Just our very presence there is a strong witness. We will also conduct an additional service project while in Jerusalem.

3) To minister prophetically – we will worship, pray and proclaim on-site – declaring God's Truth from His Word and His Spirit about that place and calling it back into its true purpose. Sometimes with only God as our audience, this may be the most important part of our ministry. However, we usually do end up with an audience as people gather to watch our dances and then ask questions. It is a wonderful way to witness and share. Sometimes they even participate!
